4. SPORT CLASSES / CLASSIFICATION

All Sport Classes are open for registration.

- For all registered athletes who are classified by the IFSC, the respective IFSC Sport Class will be adopted.
- All athletes who do not have a valid IFSC classification and those who are familiar with paraclimbing and are interested in competing will compete in an "Open Paraclimbing Class".
